The organization committee of the Nordic veteran championship in Brekstad in Norway are honored to invite all Nordic countries to the 2026 Nordic Veteran Championship in Pistol.

VENUES

The 25m, 50m and fieldshooting events will take place at Sankthansholet Shooting Center and the 10m Air Pistol event in the indoor shooting range in the middle of Brekstad city.

AWARDS

Awarding ceremonies will take place just after each competition at the shooting ranges. Nordic Veteran Games special medals will be awarded to the Champion (gold), the shooter who places second (silver) and the shooter who places third (bronze) in each event in the program. Same rule is used for team competitions.

ENTRY FEES

35 € (euro) per person per event is to be paid together with the return of the Entry Form. Team fee is 35 € per team per event. Entry fees are non-refundable and must be paid together with the return of the Entry Form no later than June 20th 2026.

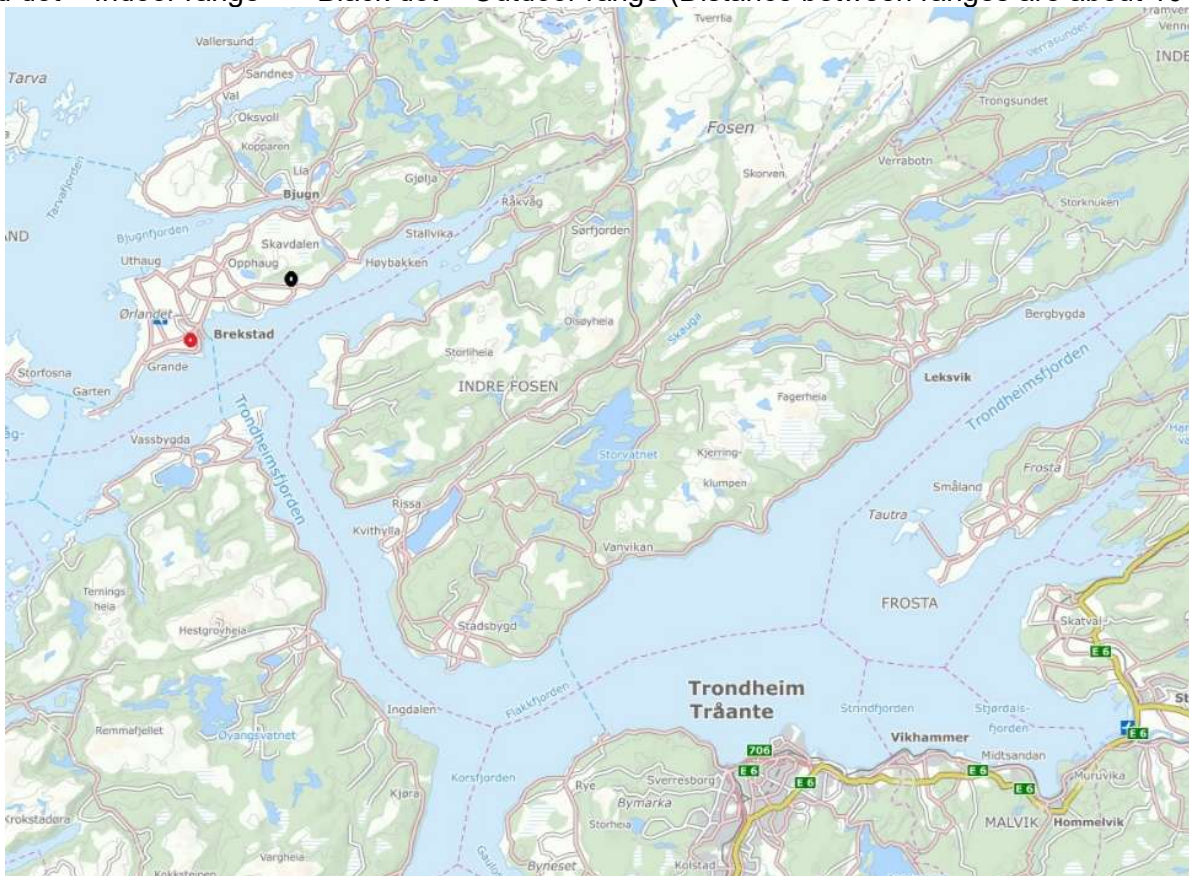

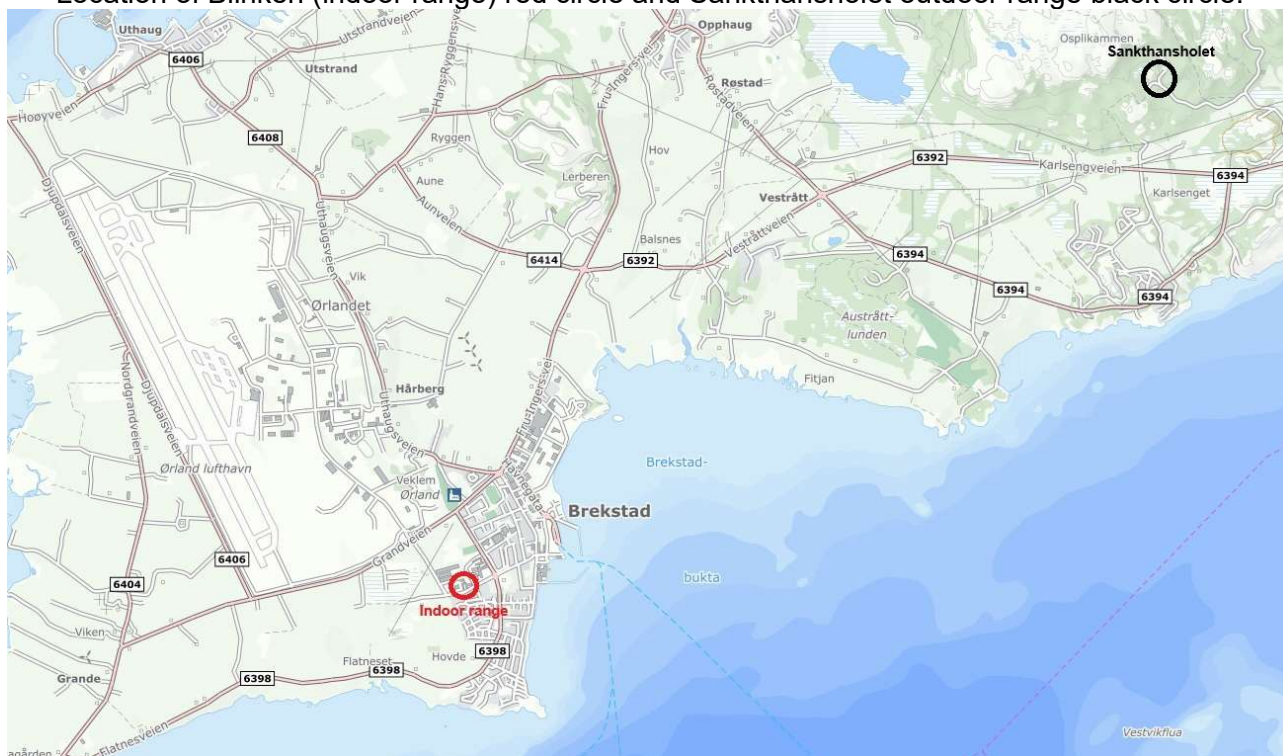
Where is Ørland? Just in the middle of the circle.



Red dot = Indoor range Black dot = Outdoor range (Distance between ranges are about 10 km)

There are many possibilities to arrive at Ørland.

From Denmark:

- Ferry to Oslo, Larvik or Kristiansand or drive via Göteborg to Oslo.
- Oslo – Elverum – Berkåk – Orkanger – Valset – Ferry to Brekstad
- A very nice and unforgettable trip will be.
Ferry to Kristiansand – Seljord – Gol – Fagernes – Valdresflye – Vågåmo – Dombås –
Oppdal – Berkåk – Orkanger – Valset – Ferry to Brekstad

From Sweden:

- Östersund – Storlien - Trondheim – Orkanger - Valset – Ferry to Brekstad
- Östersund – Storlien - Trondheim – Flakk – Ferry to Rørvik – Brekstad
- Göteborg – Oslo – Elverum – Berkåk – Orkanger – Valset – Ferry to Brekstad
- Stockholm – Sundsvall - Östersund – Storlien - Trondheim – Orkanger - Valset – Ferry to Brekstad
- Stockholm – Røros – Støren – Klett - Orkanger – Valset – Ferry to Brekstad
- Stockholm – Elverum – Berkåk - Orkanger – Valset – Ferry to Brekstad

From Finland and Estland (They must travel via Stockholm):

- Stockholm – Sundsvall - Östersund – Storlien - Trondheim – Orkanger - Valset – Ferry to Brekstad
- Stockholm – Røros – Støren – Klett - Orkanger – Valset – Ferry to Brekstad
- Stockholm – Elverum – Berkåk - Orkanger – Valset – Ferry to Brekstad

If you have a European Firearm pass you can drive this route from Östersund:

- Östersund – Duved – Sandvika – Verdal – Røra – Straumen – Meltingen – Verrabotn –
Haugsdalen – Brekstad (This is the shortest route from Östersund and there is no ferry)

If you come with airplane you must travel via Trondheim airport (TRD)

There is also a small route direct from Oslo to Brekstad. (OSL-OLA)

From Trondheim to Brekstad is possible to take a express boat, travelling time is approximately 1 hour. Time table www.atb.no
