## RULES OF TEAM EVENTS FOR DIF MEDAL MATCH

1. Medal Matches:	The Bronze Medal Match will be shot first, followed by the Gold Medal Match.
2. Bronze Medal Matches:	The 2 teams in the 2 <sup>nd</sup> place of the Semifinals will take part in the Bronze Medal Match
	<ul> <li>3 minutes preparation and sighting time</li> <li>Presentation</li> <li>50 seconds for each shot</li> <li>Single shots, one by one, for each member of the team</li> </ul>
3. Change over time:	After 5 minutes, the Teams for the Gold Medal Match will be called to the firing lines.
4. Gold Medal Match:	The 2 teams in the 1 <sup>st</sup> place of the Semifinals will take part in the Gold Medal Match
	<ul> <li>3 minutes preparation and sighting time</li> <li>Presentation</li> <li>50 seconds for each shot</li> <li>Single shots, one by one, for each member of the team</li> </ul>
5. Scoring in Medal Matches:	<ul> <li>a) All shots in the Medal Matches, will be scored with decimal scoring.</li> <li>b) The team with the highest combined score in each round, compared against the other team in the Medal Match, wins two (2) points.</li> <li>c) In case of equal scores each team receives one (1) point.</li> <li>d) The first team to reach sixteen (16) points or more will win the relevant Medal Match.</li> </ul>
6. Ties in Medal Matches:	<ul> <li>e) In case of a tie where both teams have scored at least sixteen (16) points, the Medal Match will continue with one (1) additional shot fired by both members of each team to decide the tie.</li> <li>f) If the scores are still tied the teams will continue to shoot additional shots on command until the tie is broken.</li> </ul>
